



Meredith

Meredith, 11 years old from Cantonment, Florida: on her application her mom stated the thing she wanted to remember was Meredith's smile. She was full of joy and smiles as she made her way through the park with her mom and stepfather. Meredith is diagnosed with Sanfilippo Syndrome, a rare and incurable genetic metabolism disorder. A change in a single gene makes her body unable to break down certain carbohydrates (sugars). It is found in 1 out of 70,000 births. This leads to serious problems in the brain and nervous system. Her older brother succumbed to the same disease in 2019.





Isabelle & Sophia

Isabelle, 10 years old and her sister Sophia from Marthasville, Missouri, 12 years old, both diagnosed with Cohen Syndrome.

Cohen Syndrome is an inherited disorder that affects many parts of the body and is characterized by developmental and intellectual delay. The exact incidence of the syndrome is unknown. It has been diagnosed in fewer than 1,000 people worldwide.

Ana

Ana, 14 years old from Navarre, Ohio, has Cerebral Palsy with an underlying seizure disorder. But her favorite thing to do is equine therapy and wheelchair soccer. She is nonverbal but can communicate on her talking device in both Spanish and English. We had the pleasure of having lunch with the family during their trip, and I can attest, she loves Texas BBQ and corn.
