have been provided their special trip to San Antonio.



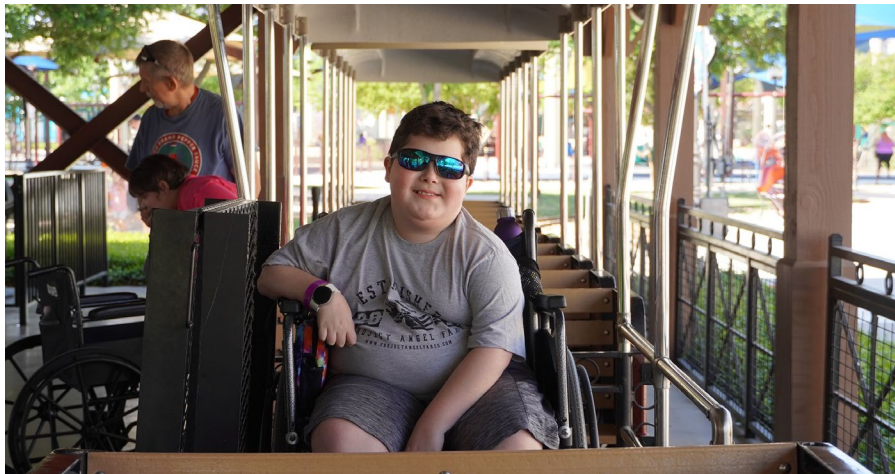

**Samuel** is a 6-year-old from Dallas, Texas, living with Type 1 spinal muscular atrophy. His mom and dad made his day by helping him enjoy the new Joy's Happy Swing.



**Brynlee (5)** and her brother **Brodee (4)**, both from Hobbs, New Mexico, live with Angelman syndrome. This rare genetic disorder affects the nervous system, causing developmental delays, intellectual disability, severe speech impairment, and challenges with movement and balance.





**Dylan (8)** and his brother **Logan (6)** are from Tinker AFB, Oklahoma. Dylan lives with hypoplastic left heart syndrome, while Logan faces autism, epilepsy, and ADHD. Their joyful, grateful family made every moment special.

**Liza (Elizabeth), 8**, made the trip from Leola, Pennsylvania, to San Antonio. She lives with mitochondrial cytopathy, a disorder that impairs her cells' energy production and often causes muscle weakness and neurological challenges.





**Callie (8)** and **Camden (9)** both from Cedar Hill, Texas, don't let their medical challenges slow them down, Callie manages congenital heart disease, and Camden thrives despite being nonverbal with autism.



**Noah**, 10 years old from Amherst, New York diagnosed with Autism, along with little brother Jude had a wonderful time at Inspiration Island. The water park was exactly what this family needed. The parents were extremely grateful for this opportunity.
